

# FAMILY LESSON - WEEK 3

**Materials Needed:** Need to Know Sheet (printed or online), Paper, Drawing Utensils

**Elementary Bible Story:** Hezekiah (2 Kings 20:1-11)

**Preschool Bible Story:** Jesus Heals a Paralyzed Man (Luke 5:17-26)



## CIRCLE UP

*Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking.*

**ASK** Give each family member a **Need to Know Sheet** or view it on the web page where you found this lesson. Have everyone decode the message to find out today's Need to Know!

**SAY** Great job! One of God's names is Healer. We call God "Healer" because He can heal every hurt and our deepest needs. Say this after me: (Pause to allow kids to repeat)

**God Is** (both hands point up)

**My Healer** (wiggle fingers in the air)

## WATCH

### ASK your Elementary Schooler:

What was wrong with Hezekiah? (He was sick) Right! Hezekiah was so sick that he was going to die.

What happened instead? (God healed him) That's right! God heard King Hezekiah's prayers and added 15 more years to his life!

God healed Hezekiah of his sickness, and God can heal us, too!

### ASK your Preschooler:

Did the hurt man's friends want to take him to get ice cream or to see Jesus? (See Jesus)


When they saw the big crowd of people, did the friends take the man home or dig a hole in the roof? (Dug a hole in the roof)

Did God heal the hurt man? (Yes) Yes! God healed the hurt man's heart and his legs! God is Healer!

## HAVE FUN TOGETHER

### DO

Draw, or take turns drawing, each of the following pictures for your family to guess. Once the image is guessed, read the following aloud, and allow your family to respond.



If you fall down and scrape your knee, what do you put on it? (Band-Aid) Yes! When we get hurt, God helps our bodies heal. God is our Healer!



If you are sad, can God heal your sadness? (Yes) Yes! God is our Healer, and He wants to heal any hurt we have. God even sent His Son, Jesus, to heal our friendship with Him. A cross makes me think of Jesus!



Sometimes your scrapes or boo-boos may be too big for a Band-Aid. Then you can wrap a big bandage around your wound. When you are hurt, does God want to heal you? (Yes)



Raise your hand if you have ever had a shot at the doctor's office. (Allow responses) Having to get a shot is not fun, but God promises to heal us when we are sick. God can use the medicine in the shots to protect us or to make us feel better!



Who loves you and takes care of you when you are sick? (Allow responses) God is also taking care of you when you are sick because God is your Healer. If you don't feel better right away, does that mean God isn't your Healer? (No) That's right! God is our Healer, but sometimes it takes time for our bodies to feel better.

### SAY

When we know that God is our Healer, we trust that He can take away every hurt! Let me hear you say this after me:

**God Is** (both hands point up)

**My Healer** (wiggle fingers in the air)

## PRAY

### PRAY

Dear God, thank You for being our Healer. We know that there is nothing too hard for You. We ask that you heal every hurt we have! We love You! In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
